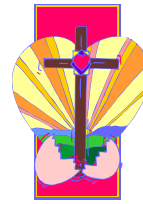
## Easter Project -

During your child's Bible Enrichment classes this year, Miss Judy will once again do a special project during the Easter season. On February 13th, eight weeks prior to Easter (which is April 8th) she is going to start the Easter story using The Resurrection Eggs, which they will make. In case you haven't heard of the Resurrection Eggs, it involves a dozen plastic eggs held in a styrofoam egg carton. Each egg will contain something like a palm leaf, a piece of cloth, a rock, etc., that will remind your child of the story. When completed, your child will bring these eggs home and should be able to relay the Easter story to you by opening each egg and revealing the piece inside.

Early Discovery and Little Learners will discover Spring with God's new life; such as chicks, rainbows and flowers. Then we will go into the Jesus and the Easter Story. Pre-K will learn the Easter story in more detail. Each parent will receive a copy of the story their child will learn.

Each child needs to bring in:

- a styrofoam egg carton (1 dozen size)
- 12 plastic eggs, the regular size ones (not the large ones) any color is fine.



Miss Judy will provide the remainder of the items that go inside the eggs. Again, we will start this project on February 13th, so we need the egg cartons NOW! And we need the 12 plastic eggs as soon as they are in the stores. I know the eggs will be hard to find in the stores at the moment, but usually the Dollar Stores have them first. 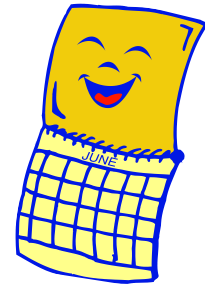
